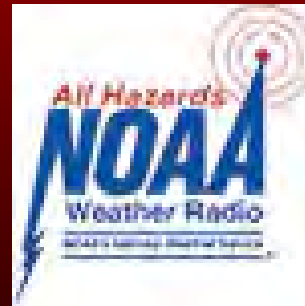



To confirm call this number, 800-986-4132, and give the TSRA organization number 892807736723502. 4) If you do not confirm, hang up, or the call is answered by an answering machine, the system will keep cycling through your contact methods until you confirm receipt, or the broadcast timeframe expires. The text concludes with: "Our first priority in notification is your Sea Ranch house which is critical for wildfire evacuations and tsunami alerts."
